- 2) NAME OF THE PROJECT Educational Augmented Reality App to help understanding and communication in children with autism and disabilities.
- 3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT
 - a. WHAT? improve the communication of children with disabilities, especially autism.
 - b. HOW? Through the use of Augmented Reality technology to optimize learning by generating a great visual impact that sets concepts more effectively than simple texts or conventional images.
 - c. WHEN? All this during their work with therapists and relatives.
 - d. WHY? The rationale behind this is that children with autistic spectrum relate and interact with technological devices in a fabulous way, otherwise it is usually very complicated to interact with them and minimal results are obtained.
- 4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG-TERM BREAK DOWN

The premises of this project are planned according to the following stages:

SHORT TERM:





- a. Develop the programming of an exclusive and FREE Augmented Reality App for education of children with disabilities (programming, panels, stores, servers, etc.). The grant funds will be used to generate 6 educational contents (3D animations and modeling) through programmers and experts in Augmented Reality.
- b. Distribute digitally and physically (books, stickers, games) images to support the understanding of different subjects, which will be integrated into the App; these images consist of illustrations that integrate Augmented Reality technology that allows you to visualize 3D educational animations literally floating on the sticker, which really improves communication and interaction.

LONG TERM:

- a. Already with the App working and the first active contents integrated, we will begin to add other contents in stages, seeking support from different institutions to generate these contents and thus covering a wide spectrum of subjects that help understanding and have a novel visual impact and fun, as it is to visualize content in Augmented Reality.
- b. The App will be expanded as to be useful for all children regardless of their condition.
- c. The App will be made available into the community of the "Iluminemos de Azul" association and its associated centers, which is recognized by the Mexican government and works with the Ministry of Health in programs for the inclusion and education of disabled people; in addition, the App will be made available for free downloads.

5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY (AS APPLICABLE)

The rights of use of the Resulting App will be ceded to Rotary International and to "Iluminemos de Azul" for further development and widespread use worldwide (the App will show the logos of the two institutions).

The beneficiaries will be minors and adolescents with various disabling pathologies within the community of the "Iluminemos de Azul" association (the most important in Mexico).

Studies will be carried out to assess the cognitive improvement and monitoring of children's progress (subject to parental authorization).
