3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

We are working this project with CLIMA (Clínica Mexicana de Autismo y Alteraciones del Desarrollo, A.C.), a clinic that strives to have a constant improvement in all their services. Currently, there is a necessity to replace the furniture of their intervention classrooms since they are already very damaged and their useful life is about to end. The needs of the people with autism that is served by the clinic are very variable, which is why the furniture required are also very diverse.

SHORT TERM:

Replace the furniture (tables and chairs) of work rooms, seeking to meet the different needs of people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD); this stage is the one that will be covered by the H2H grant.

MEDIUM TERM:



Remodel the Labor Workshop in which adults with ASD carry out crafts that the clinic brings to the market so that they can have the experience of a labor inclusion and receive an income.

LONG TERM:

Help the clinic to acquire an apartment near its premises, in which young people and adults can receive independent life training in order to acquire new autonomy skills.
