3) OBJETIVE

Make possible the inclusion of technology to communities of low resources and high rates of violence, with children from 10 to 15 years of age being our specific sector. Giving them the possibility of having a quality education, in topics related to Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics, that can help them in this changing and globalized world that is full of new challenges every day, taking advantage of their talent and channeling to the area that can best develop its potential.

4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG TERM DEGLOZED SHORT TERM:

For this project we have drawn a line of action that consists of development facets in which we will measure the before, during and after the impact we are having with the children.

SHORT TERM:

The program will last 3 and 4 weeks, we will have the capacity of 10-15 students, with theoretical-practical sessions / classes that promote not only the interest of children but also awaken in them the passion for technology and innovation that can generate a radical change for your future and that of the world if possible.



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FASE 1 (Diagnosis)

Provide children with the first introductory and diagnostic class that allows us to know what prior knowledge they have of the subjects.

This will allow us to know from where to start and the speed at which we can go because we do not want only the class but true impact being the knowledge transmitted the basis for the start of the project.

Verifying from the beginning:

° The Attitude to technology (true interest in knowledge and inclusion in technology) The retention and application of technology that children can give priority to focus on a sector if possible, from the beginning (Robotics, Programming, design etc.) " Classes are held every Saturday with a duration of 2 to 3 hours combining practical theoretical sessions with rest periods and coexistence of 5 a 10min per hour "

FASE 2

Having identified the area of interest and channeling the group in the same direction, to provide the classes focused on the professional development of the group further promoted, leadership, teamwork, friendship and fellowship that Rotary encourages in us by planting in them not only technology and innovation as a weapon for the future but also the necessary values for its growth, generating from there a support and network of contacts that they will develop, supporting each other.

LONG TERM:

The intention of the STEM Initiative is for children and young people to be prepared for the jobs of the future and to get the most out of the program. Our long-term goal is for children to be inspired and inspire others to use technology..

FASE 3

Once the sessions / classes are over, we will look for each child to generate at the end of the course a project that consist in use what he has learned in something that improves if possible his community, his family, his life, his school, etc. That impacts positively and that generates the small change (to begin with) that we hope will be undertaken by themselves.

This project will be a team of 3 children who, in addition to promoting teamwork, provide the ability to interact with others differently from school and with it the opportunity to apply new and fresh knowledge in the generation of something new and that allow positive change to something or someone we hope to make this a chain of well-being for each child, their peers, and their lives onwards.



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FASE 4

MONITORING : After a period of between 4 and 8 months, review the true impact that the initiative had for each child that has really inspired and generated a change, that the new knowledge has not only been to be 3 hours every Saturday for a month and that in At least 20% of children change their future and if possible have created in them the necessary inspiration not only to change their world but to change the world.

With this we intend to create a model that is viable and solid that later other clubs within the republic can replicate.
