2) NAME OF THE PROJECT: Second Project Stage for construction  
finishes in black work and equipment for Sanitary and Water Filters  
Placement at Enrique Pestalozzi Telesecundaria School, in the  
Community of San Antonio Paso del Toro, Xalapa Veracruz

3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT: It is a Service Project for Education  
of a group of Secondary Education Students, whose socially and  
economically marginalized situation does not allow them to access a  
better level of education, lacking adequate space to carry out the  
activities of the process of teaching-learning, in the first stage  
the Rotary Club Millenium of Xalapa provided with television screens,  
computer, paints, paint, books and Education Workshops on Topics such  
as Gender Equity, Reproductive Health, Preventive Measures in the  
Event of an Accident , among others. In the present Rotary Year the  
continuation of the Project is to conclude the Work of the Sanitary  
Ware since they are in a deplorable situation (annex photos). The  
Parents provided the Workforce and the Club with the construction  
materials.

4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: This is a specific Education Project,  
but also for Disease Prevention, since the water that students drink  
is not drinkable and the disposal of waste is very unhealthy, as well  
as unworthy when shared by women and men. The particular objectives  
are to contribute to improve the quality of Education and Health of



children and youth of this community and for future generations, as well as the dignification of education and improvement in their quality of life.

Short Term: This Telesecundaria School is attended by approximately 90 young people at all three levels, they come from families with low economic resources and although the center is incorporated into the Education System of the State of Veracruz, the classrooms were built for 30 years by the Community itself. Particularly noteworthy are the facilities of the health services which are otherwise deficient and insufficient, (annex photos)

In the Long Term: By directly providing the support requested in this Project, the quality of the school stay will be substantially improved and as a result teaching and learning, diseases with the intake of Drinking Water and Hygiene are prevented and may also have decent spaces, which will result in a benefit for students, teachers and future generations of students.

#### 5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY:

##### Process:

1.-The request for support is received from the parents and the Telesecundaria Headmaster. (annexes)

2.-The School is visited and the needs of it are verified, since said property has been built by the community, that is, it is not a building owned by the Education Services, the equipment and maintenance is by the Parents.

3.-The Society of Parents is willing to provide labor.

4.-The Project is viable and has sustainability since it is aimed at a highly vulnerable population due to its marginalization conditions, as well as its social and economic stratum and that once the intervention of the Rotarians has been withdrawn, the facilities will continue to function. It has teachers assigned and paid by the Ministry of Public Education of Veracruz, as well as covered the operation costs of the facilities.

6) DIRECT AND INDIRECT BENEFICIARIES: 90 Students, Teachers, visitors to the school and relatives of the students.

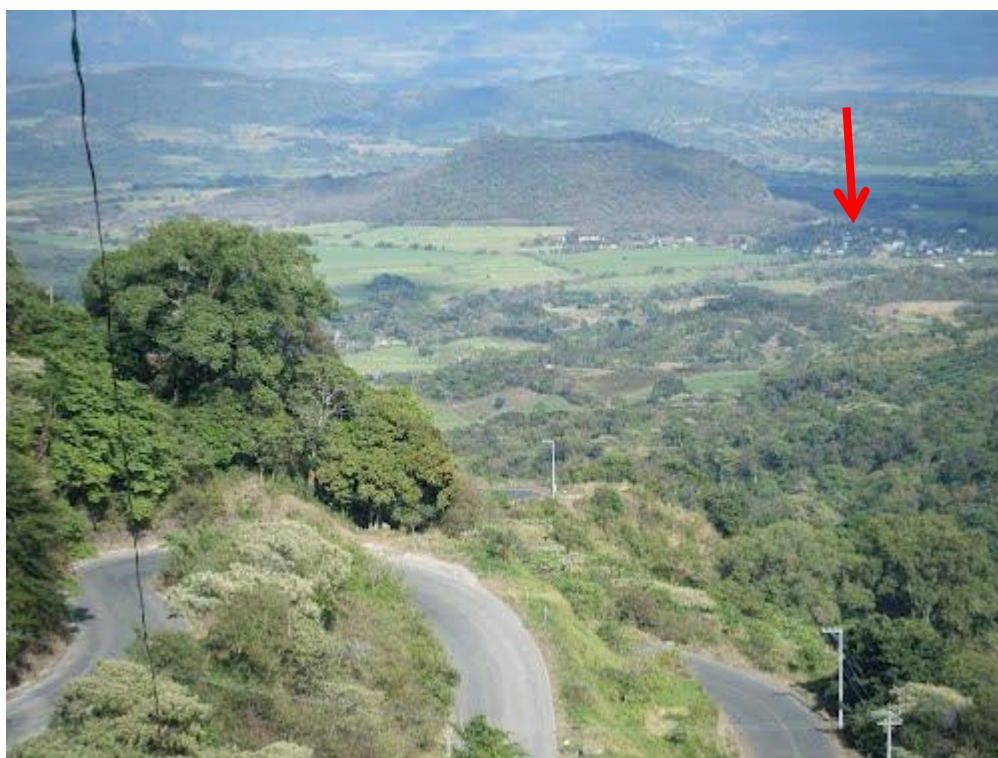
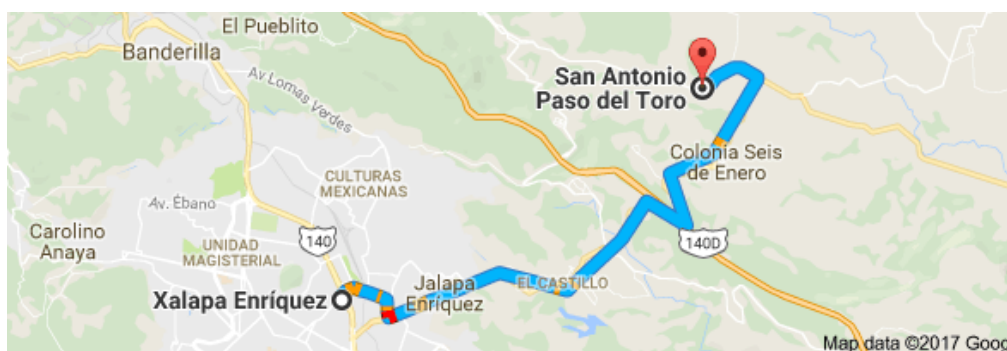
