2) NAME OF THE PROJECT

Educating with and for Peace in Acapulco

3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

The objective is to sensitize and train managers, teachers and parents of five public, primary and secondary schools, in Acapulco, Guerrero, with the purpose of promoting with the students the values of the culture of Peace, generating their own processes to create safe conditions on campus.

Promote the culture of peace in public schools in Acapulco, sensitizing and developing teachers for the intervention of transversal activities in the curriculum that promote the values of the Culture of Peace.

4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG-TERM BREAK DOWN

Short term:

- Selection of five participating public schools, through the issuance of a public call. Schools can be primary or secondary morning or evening shifts.



- Making a school diagnosis in each of the selected educational institutions (public schools).
- Adaptation of the methodology and implementation of the schedule and work plan for each of the participating schools.
- Initial training for managers and teachers of each public school.
- Initial meeting with parents for the presentation and explanation of the project.

Medium term:

- Weekly follow-up by the advisor assigned to each educational Institution, to make a personalized accompaniment to managers and teachers, in the understanding, management and use of the concepts and values of the Culture of Peace.
- Teacher training program (8 sessions during the school year).
- Teaching workshops to parents during the school year (one monthly).
- Implementation of weekly activities with students through teachers. With the support of a manual for the student, with weekly activities to know and practice the values of: justice, truth, respect, putting

Long term:

- At the end of the school year, an evaluation will be carried out to measure the impact of the methodology implemented.
- Suggestions of modifications will be made according to the results obtained in each Institution for the implementation of activities in the following school year.
- Periodic communication will be maintained with the Institutions to maintain preventive support.
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5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY (AS APPLICABLE)

By forming capacities within the Institution in the first year of work, through a process of capacity building, skills and techniques in the construction of Peace in teachers, the project guarantees its sustainability in the short and medium term, since Each Institution will follow up on the actions implemented because they will have the necessary knowledge to carry out their own school follow-up.
