Request an Ophthalmologic Surgical Microscope to donate to Dr. Raymundo Abarca Alarcón General Hospital to operate on low-income patients diagnosed with Cataract and Pterygium to become self-sufficient people.

4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG TERM DETAILED OBJECTIVES OF THE "LIGHT FOR YOUR EYES" PROJECT

1.-SHORT TERM.

With the ophthalmologic surgical microscope, patients with limited economic resources can be operated with a diagnosis of Cataract and Pterygium, without having to move to other cities, to lead a life with greater independence and reintegrate into an economically active life to improve their general environment.





2.-LONG TERM.

Promote that people with visual disabilities secondary to Cataract and Pterygium who benefited from surgery can recover their labor productivity and have elements for greater inclusion in social, family, work, cultural and political life. We are convinced that people with the best vision can become very productive at work.

5) EXPLANATION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THE PROJECT IF YOU HAVE IT

Due to the lending nature of the Project, which consists of operating patients with small economic resources and difficulty in moving to other cities for treatment, it is not possible to generate economic resources that reduce the Club to recover the investment made with the purchase of the ophthalmological surgical microscope; however, the sustainability of the Project lies in the beneficiaries that are operated, recover the vision, recover working life and obtain economic resources; in such a way that the sustainability of the Project lies in making people with a high degree of vulnerability self-sufficient, to the extent that by being able to incorporate the affected labor market in better conditions to support their community and their families.

6) DIRECT AND INDIRECT BENEFICIARIES BREAKDOWN YOUR VULNERABLE SITUATION ATTACHING IMAGES.

In the General Hospital Dr. Raymundo Abarca Alarcón de Chilpancingo, Guerrero, approximately 2,200 patients are treated in the ophthalmology service in the morning and evening shifts annually, of which 12% with a diagnosis of Cataract and Pterygium are referred to other cities to be operated, generating economic and emotional wear on patients and their families.
