- 3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT:
 - The main objective of this project is to know the demands of justice of indigenous communities determined by the specialists that make up the teaching cloister of the Faculty of Law of UNACH, and at the same time, design, transmit and deliver courses adequate to the needs of these peoples that allow a culture of peace and resolve intra- and inter-community conflicts.
 - This program seeks to meet the various demands for justice, create a culture of peace and conflict resolution in indigenous communities and achieve institutional coverage to these now neglected populations.
- 4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG-TERM BREAK DOWN
 The State of Chiapas is an entity in the sury oftheexicano that has
 the highest rates of marginalization and poverty in Mexico, this
 is a result of the abandonment that the municipal, local and federal
 authorities have had this entity. It should be noted that Chiapas
 has the highest unemployment rate, informal jobs, little social
 security coverage, and lack of care in medicines and low economic
 growth.

The communities that account for the largest percentage of these indices are communities or municipalities with mostly indigenous populations, which are in accessible with little educational infrastructure, services, communication, as well as lack of internet access.

Alongside this economic delay are the various demands for justice that indigenous communities or peoples demand, such as the attention of basic demands, drinking water, sewerage, medical care among others; demands in compliance with the rule of law and legality, as well as the protection of human rights and the indigenous rights of these peoples.

That is why, in the face of these demands, the lack of resources makes it impossible to be physically with these communities, so it is necessary to use new forms of communication through the network that allow to address the gaps that these justices still suffer in matters of justice still suffer Peoples.

5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY (AS APPLICABLE)

This seeks to patent the strong tradition in higher education that counts the FACULTy of Law of UNACH, which, must be extended to remote places of the Chiapas geography and with needs and demands of justice as they turn out to be the various municipalities and indigenous communities.
