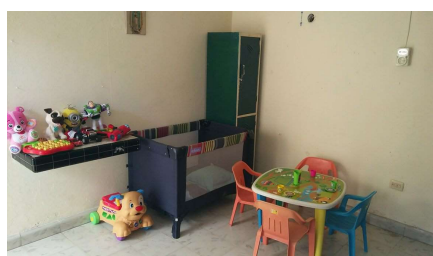
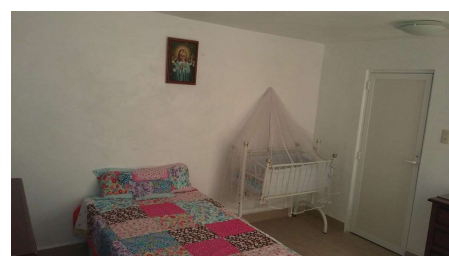

- PREGNANT WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN IN MANAGEMENT, IN THE SITUATION OF VULNERABILITY WHICH COME TO THE HOST OF A.M.E., REQUESTING SUPPORT FOR ACCESS TO PRENATAL CONTROLS, MANY OF WHICH TEEN EXPUNGED FROM THE NUCOUAR FAMILY NARLE
- YOUNG ADOLESCENTS OF EDUCATIONAL CENTERS OF THE TIMUCUY AND ABALA COMMUNITIES, IN REPRODUCTIVE AGE, FROM DIRECT EXPERIENCES APPRECIATING A LIVING ULTRASOUND, THEY CAN APPRECIATE GESTATIONAL DEVELOPMENT, REFLECT AND REPLACE THE RESPECT


