Since 1982, the Mexican Association to Help Children with Cancer, IAP (AMANC) is the first institution in the country, and the only one with a national presence, to provide comprehensive accompaniment to the treatment of children and adolescents with cancer.



There are more and more cases of children with cancer in Mexico.

- 1st cause of death by disease in patients aged 5 to 14 years
- 7million new cases of childhood and adolescent cancer per year
- 23million cases in active treatment each year
- 3 out of 4 cases of childhood cancer are detected in advanced stages
- 57% national survival rate
- 2024 H2H partners (\$7,000)
  - several D6780 TN clubs including Maryville, Bearden and Knoxville Volunteer, Carmel IN D6560, plus individuals (Ken Ota, Jeff Johnston, Mike Martin, Becky Doyle, and Ron Appuhn)

- The waiting list in Mexico for a kidney transplant is approximately 12,000 people
- The cost of having a transplant surgery performed is prohibitive for the patients we work with.
- Training of doctors on live donor transplant surgery

## GOAL:

- Performing approximately 100 live donor kidney transplants
- Training multiple physicians on how to perform live donor kidney transplant surgery
- Saving individual lives and entire families
- Promote the the practice of live donor transplants
