There are good days and bad days. She has thought many of times of just ending her life because she see's no way of getting past this. With lots of love and support from family, friends and professionals she has made it thru those rough times and continues to fight today.

Present day this young woman continues her fight for herself and others. She feels her confidence coming back and can spend some time alone outside of her house, to smell the flowers, see the wind blow, meet other people. She still has panic attacks and nightmares but can cope with them better now. The pain never goes away, she finds Beauty in The Small Things.

This now amazing 21-year-old women is my daughter Allie. I couldn't be prouder of her and her willing to fight and continue fighting for her dreams. She means the world to me and so many others.
