City Of Forest Grove Public Works Plans

If you're reading this newsletter and you attend the June 6th Rotary meeting you will notice a few similarities. Here I will list and discuss a few of the highlights in the Public Works project schedule for the next 18 months or so.

The rest of 2018 and most of 2019 will be highlighted by some major transportation projects, two of which two are listed.

Martin Road – Washington County will be improving the south end of Martin Road from Oregon Roses to Highway 47 in Forest Grove. The improvements will consist of widening the existing lanes and adding shoulders. Also a new wider bridge will be installed to cross Council Creek, improvements at the intersection with Highway 47. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has jurisdiction of the highway and has final approval of the intersection improvements. This much needed project will improve the access from the north to Forest Grove.

The City's primary interest is the intersection with the highway. Currently the plan is proposing a round-a-bout rather than a signal light. The round-a-bouts north of town are working well and the design engineers feel that this location will also work well. This project is being funded through the County's Major Streets and Transportation Program (MSTIP) which is supported by County property tax. The City of Forest Grove is funding 10% of the project from development fee money. Note that no gas tax is used in funding this project. Gasoline tax is used completely for the repair and maintenance of existing streets, mainly replacement of worn asphalt.

Fern Hill Road – The next transportation project is a dangerous intersection on highway 47 at Fern Hill Road. Crossing the highway at this intersection is challenging for a number of reasons. The City would like to either signalize this intersection or construct another round-a-bout. A detailed engineering analysis is needed first to determine which of these two options is best. This project is also funded by the County MSTIP program and the City's development fee. Future money will be needed for construction. This intersection improvement project is solely for the purpose of improving safety at the intersection. The presence of the railroad complicates the design and might prohibit the possibility of around-a-bout.
