This idyllic scene of Baring Creek in Glacier National Park also has a memory.

This scene caught my eye and I wished to photograph it. Linda and I had just walked about 1/2 mile below this scene to view a 40' falls. Tremendous water cascading over impressive rocks. Returning upstream from viewing the falls I decided to photograph this cascade. Linda returned a short distance to the car to read while I photographed.

To reach the stream edge was down an embankment. There was a family with young children at the stream edge. I didn't see any problem working my way down. I had worked my way down the embankment with camera and tripod in one hand hanging on with the other. When I was close I decided I could jump the last little bit and land on the small flat area next to the water.

There is always one more detail to know which I learned after I jumped. The stone edge had a dusting of fine sand on top and as I landed I immediately slipped into the swift current of the stream. Luckily I caught myself on my elbows on the edge of the rock with my camera and equipment still in my hands. Trying to get footing to climb back on the stone edge I found the underwater rocks all covered with a very slick film with no traction. I couldn't pull myself out on my own. Quick thinking, decisions, what to do next?

Some of the family were climbing back up the embankment, but the woman was still on the rock. She grabbed me and held on till others could come help pull me out. Was I ever fortunate she was still there! I was envisioning being washed down the stream to the falls wondering if I could reach a bank before then. I've thanked my lucky stars more than once.

Meanwhile Linda was still up on the road in the car. I was drenched from the waist down and I still hadn't photographed the scene. Although being wet I decided to go ahead and photograph, while the adrenaline rush subsided. I spent about 1/2 hour photographing and then had return to tell Linda what had happened. She is always convinced I need a keeper and this only reinforced her belief.

This photo is a blending together of about 14 individual camera shots.

I often thought of giving this the title of 'Going to the Falls'. I'm very grateful to be here still.
