President Mike Soden rang the bell promptly at 7am. Following a break to enjoy our meals and converse, all joined in the pledge of allegiance. Guests and visiting Rotarians were introduced by Past President Ashley Mahaney. Guests included potential new member Bob Hulshouser, a former Rotarian and past president of three clubs in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Ashley introduced visiting Rotarians: Ed Cooper, Hammatt, Hugh Ledford, John Chase, and Roger Gama.

Mike told us that new member Dave Chase has stepped forward to be our new Polio Plus Chairman. Dave, a polio survivor, who spent time in an iron lung, made a "from the heart" pitch to join in the final push to eradicate polio. Dave and DG Elect Larry Skaggs told us that the district is looking for \$55.00 per member to total \$100,000 for our District. That \$100,000 will be matched 2:1 by the Gates Foundation for a total of \$300,000. There are time constraints on obtaining the match, so bring your check to Thursday's meeting.

Our Speaker for the day, Henderson Councilman Sam Bateman, presented the Club with a Proclamation from the City signed by Mayor Hafen, proclaiming October 24, 2013 WORLD POLIO DAY. The Proclamation noted Rotary's worldwide effort to extinguish the disease and our club's longstanding participation in that effort.

Fines, wheel twisting, the usual trivia quiz, and happy - not so happy dollars were presided over by DGE Larry with his usual aplomb and enthusiasm. Notable tales included Jim Servino being famously photographed sans Rotary pin. Judge Susan Johnson happily contributed following her return from the Sonoma County wine country
