Gerry Holinski introduced our guest speaker, Liberty Leavitt, Graduation Initiative Coordinator, CCSD -Community Partnership Program. Her presentation focused on the many ways in which organizations, businesses and individuals can contribute to student academic achievement through established "Partnership Points". She described program opportunities including the Focus School Project; Stay in School Mentoring; Reclaim Your Future Mentoring Project; Professionals and Youth Building a Commitment (PAYBAC); Curriculum – Based Programs; Safe Routes to School, and Support-a-School Program.

Leavitt said that, "The School Mentoring Program has a 90% graduation rate for participating students." She explained that a high percentage of school drop outs become involved in unlawful activities, and her programs are designed to keep more students in school. Leavitt discussed numerous ways in which our Rotary Club can support this exemplary youth services program. She indicated that a need for program support exists in the middle schools. Our Interact Clubs are also encouraged to participate in such programs as reading initiatives at the middle school level.

Acting Treasurer Mike Soden held the weekly raffle drawing. The pot is still growing, as Dave Jochman didn't draw the joker. Dave led the club in reciting the Four Way Test. President Jack adjourned the meeting at about 8:20 a.m.
