District Qualifications



- District leaders complete qualification process online annually.
- Agree to implement Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
- Facilitate Grant Management Seminars for Clubs.

Club Qualifications



- Agree to implement the club Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and other necessary documents.
- At least two (2) Club members (preferably one should be the 2020-2021 Club President) participate in the Grant Management Seminar.
- Enter Club's Rotary Foundation giving goals in Rotary Club Central.

Club Qualifications (con't)




- Appoint a Club Foundation Committee Chair and advise RI and District Office of name and contact information.
- Current as to Rotary International and District 6200 dues.
- Previous District Grant Projects have been successfully closed out.
