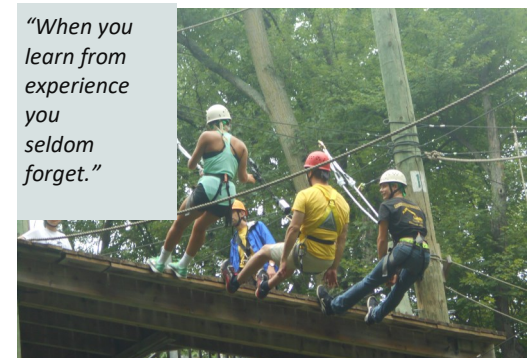


Camp is limited to 60 students this year. Applicants will be accepted on the basis of receipt of their completed and approved applications from their community Rotary Club.
