## PROGRAM

**Mark Mitchell** opened the program, sharing when he was young he donated a kidney to his brother and did not impact his life at all – Now he needs a new kidney, but not because he gave his. He was suppose to have surgery today but an infection prohibited it. He is pleased to share personally about the various donor programs.

**Bob McGaughy** introduced Robin Peterson–Webster, RN, highlighting her 30 years – 1st at Riverside and most recent 20 years at the Wexner Center OSU. She lives in Galena, is married with a 20 year old daughter. She likes to travel and read. Robin shared that OSU is a world leader in transplant research with 50–years experience, 9000 since 1967, 6000 kidneys. They are nationally ranked for multiple transplant organs. Patient survival rates are in the top 10% by volume.

Robin explained a kidney's function is to filter waste from blood, regulate blood pressure, regulate electrolyte and fluid balance and regulate red blood production. This organ is a power house. Transplants allow people to avoid peritoneal dialysis which is exhausting and impacts health and is limiting. Live donors help the severe shortage of deceased organs and help patients heal faster. Donors will be left with 66–75% of original kidney function and are not responsible for fees associated with medical evaluation and donation of their kidney.

She reviewed the criteria for those considering:

- Person comes to this on their own with no coercion.
- Must b 18–70 years old with excellent physical and mental health.
- Non–directed donors must be at least 21 years of age.
- Willing and able to complete testing and understand risks and potential complications.
- Must have a stable life situation with strong social support.
- Be willing to stop smoking and drinking alcohol for a period before and after donation.
- Must be willing to commit to follow-up for two years after donation.

She explained the selection process and healing time, mentioning the surgery only lasts 2 hours and a healing time of 3 days at home.
