



Corporate Commitment

Term: The Corporate Membership is for one year and is renewable. If the membership starts during the Rotary year (July-June) then pro-rated membership dues will be calculated.

Meetings: The Rotary Club of Westerville meets from Noon-1p.m.on Thursdays at the Medallion Club. Individuals will get the most out of the membership by attending regularly. The meeting includes an optional lunch for \$20. For members not eating there is a \$5 cover charge.

Dues: All Rotary International clubs pay dues on an annual basis (July – June). The first employee membership would be: \$375.00. Additional employee memberships are discounted at: \$260.

Assignment: Organizations may transfer the membership of an employee who leaves the organization during their membership year to another employee.
