Nineteen restaurants and suppliers have been selected for Taste of College Park 2024 to be held at The Great Southern Box Co. Food Hall & Bar on Thursday, October 10, 2024, from 6pm to 9PM. Once again, Taste of College Park will be "College Park's Best Night Out!"

First time restaurants are The Drake Kitchen + Bar (f/k/a Duck & Drake Kitchen), and newly opened College Park Mid Drive Dive and Parlor Doughnuts. Other first-time restaurants are The Current Seafood Counter, Hawkers Asian Street Food, Jeff's Bagel Run, Cups and Pups Coffee and Great Southern Box Company Food Hall at the Packing District. Returning from last year are The Tap Room/Events by Dubsdread, Armando's, Infusion Tea, The Pinery, Tijuana Flats, The Monroe, Nothing Bundt Cakes, Kelly's Homemade Ice Cream, Chef Crystal Clarke, 4 Rivers Smokehouse, and The Castle Irish Pub & Restaurant. Ivanhoe Park Brewing Company will return as the beer provider and Digress Wine will provide the wine selections. Publix Super Market at College Park will provide water, supplies and other support.

Taste of College Park is the **Rotary Club of College Park Foundation's** premier fundraising event. In previous years, more than \$40,000 per year has been raised for local charities and programs benefiting the College Park community. Taste of College Park combines food, beer, wine, entertainment, and an online/silent auction for an extraordinary evening in College Park. Local restaurants and distributors provide the food, beer, and wine, local retailers supply items for the online/silent auction and College Park residents support the event by purchasing tickets, bidding on auction items, and coming out to enjoy the evening. Taste of College Park has become, "College Park's Best Night Out!"

The online/silent auction at www.BiddingforGood.com/RotaryClubofCollegePark will open on September 10, 2024, and will close the night of Taste of College Park 2024 at 8:30PM. Tickets will be available through the club's website at www.RotaryCollegePark.org and from club members.
