3. **Please bring extra cash** to the Wednesday as your donations and the money from Happy Talk will be given to Angela as our annual gift thanking her for her service throughout the year.



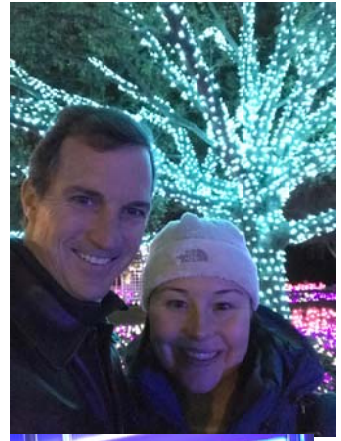
4. **The special drawing** this month during the raffle is a lovely poinsettia centerpiece. Be sure to buy your tickets!
