DaCdb - *Direct Connect* Interface to RI

Record Access = Some Confusion

- Changes in both Club and & Member records are automatically communicated to RI and changed in the RI database.
- Some changes are done via *Direct Connect* other changes are done via an email to RI.
- **Direct Connect** changes supposedly happen within 5 minutes...had a recent report that it took a day.
- Email updates may take 2 to 4 weeks...depending on email volume received at RI.
- What changes are communicated via *Direct Connect* and what changes are done via email are RI decisions, not a DaCdb decision. As things go forward more updates will be done via *Direct Connect*.

What is *Direct Connect*?

An electronic handshake interface between DaCdb and the RI Database. At this time there are 14 clubs in D7630 who have enabled Direct Connect.

Enabling *Direct Connect*

Comparing DaCdb records and RI Records:

Once *Direct Connect* is enabled Club Officers can compare what is shown in a DaCdb record and what is shown in the matching RI record. Below is the DaCdb horizontal menu that a Level 4 Club Officer will see....*RI Compare*



Summary and Suggestions:

- The Club President or Club Secretary should update DaCdb as it will communicate those changes to RI either via email or *Direct Connect*.
- Conversely RI <u>does not</u> download information to DaCdb.
- If the RI record is updated first, the DaCdb record must still be updated. This has lead to complaints of why should I have to enter the data twice. Answer is that you don't as long as you update DaCdb first.
- Note that DaCdb contains no data or information on Rotary Foundation contributions and reports...for that you must still use RI Member access. Go To <u>www.rotary.org</u> and click <u>Member Access</u>.
