# SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS FROM ORANGE,

Each year, The Orange Rotary offers scholarships to Orange residents who are secondary school Seniors planning on attending college or other recognized post-secondary institutions.

- This year, four scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded to four graduating seniors.
- Two scholarships are designated for students planning to study in the liberal arts and two for those planning undergraduate study in mathematics or the sciences.
- The scholarships are a one-time lump sum given directly to seniors who have been accepted at an accredited institution and plan to attend in 2025-2026.
- Awardees must be residents of Orange, Connecticut, and United States citizens.
- No member of the immediate family of any Rotarian is eligible for a scholarship.
- Scholarships are presented to each successful applicant by Orange Rotary Club Members in Late-May or early June.
- The attached application and supporting materials are the sole basis for awarding the scholarships.
