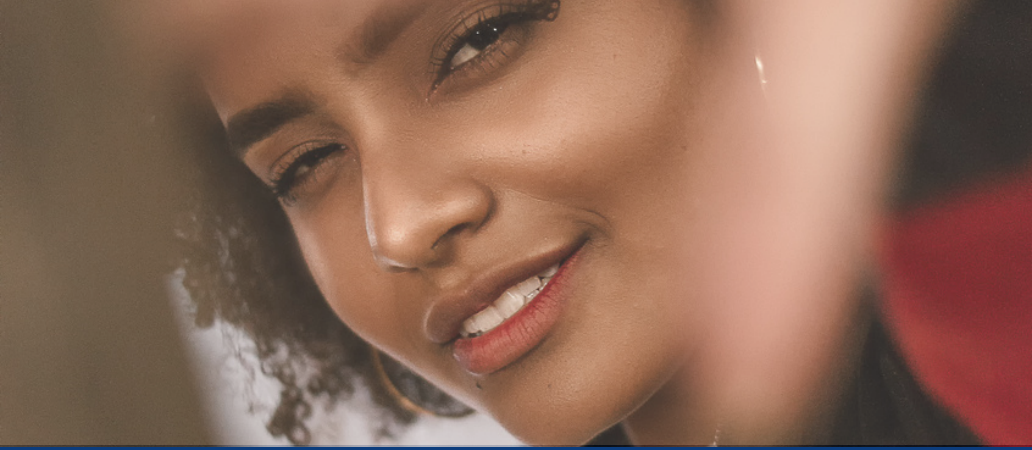

IMPACT FUND

The Impact Fund provides financial assistance to Rotarians and Rotaractors through a one-time grant of 500 dollars. Anyone interested can apply online and will be asked to describe in detail their career transition and the hardship it has placed on their financial circumstances.

Applications are completely anonymous. The grant committee reviews applications on a case-by-case basis and make awards to qualified candidates. To date, eight grants have been awarded. Read below to hear what former grant recipients have to say about the impact this program made on their lives.

The Impact fund is supported by donations from individuals, Rotary clubs and districts, and corporate sponsors. Giving to the Impact Fund helps provide financial assistance to participants in our program who need it in order to be successful in their current or future career.
