Jess Gutzwiler |District International Service Chair | Jess now has three Rotarians on her committee. She is working with DGE Marty Metiva on a District wide International project.

**Peggy Pollen** |Foundation Chair| She is preparing for the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Foundation Gala that will be taking place by Zoom on 12/17/24. This event thanks those who have made contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

**Diane Fejes** |Foundation District Endowments/Major Gifts | She is working on club presentations to educate on the "how to" for endowments and major gifts to the Rotary Foundation. Our District has the funding available in the form of District Designated Funds (DDF) and Foundation leadership will be working on how to designate these funds in a meaningful way.

**Denny Dewitt** |District Conference | Meetings continue as plans are made for the May District Conference being held in Juneau, May 1<sup>st</sup>-4th. Be sure to get signed up, Juneau is rolling out the red carpet!

**Gayle Knepper** |Growth & Learning, US-Russia Inter Country Committee, MOP Update | Gayle, Alana and Bernie are working on the Leadership Lab that will be a 7-month series of online and group courses. The emphasis will be to form "Learning Communities" where groups get together and move through this education together. Registration will end in May and the courses will start in September. Gayle asks that committee chairs consider leading the "areas of focus" that they represent. The MOP will have a policy manual along with the updated Manual of Practice. These revisions will be voted on at the Annual Meeting. **Bill Simpson** |Excess Reserves Committee Chair | D5010 has \$194,000 in undesignated funds.

**Tam Agosti-Gisler** | Interact | She is working on the recertification of many of the D5010 Interact clubs and is personally attending the meetings with the Interact students. She will be asking that our District become a certifies to make Presidential Volunteer Awards so that she can make recognition of volunteerism an important part of the Interact programs.

Globally, there are 33,000 PHS members. The Council on Resolutions met in October and voted on 44 resolutions. There was one appeal voted on as well. These move on to the COL. The COL meets every three years in person in Chicago and that will take place in April 2025. **Beth Trowbridge** |RYLA| The local and statewide committees are working hard to get things organized. RYLA is taking place March 27<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> in

Ketchikan. The flier and registration forms will be coming out soon.

**Mike Bridges** |District Risk Manager | The D5010 Risk team has completed the Crisis Intervention exercise with the District Governor line. Three scenarios were used to test the readiness of our District and the leadership to respond to such scenarios. The team was pleased with the outcomes and performance of the current DG line.

**Cindy Wright** |International Conference | D5010 has met our goal for enrollment to the Rotary International Conference in Calgary. Be watching for the invitation to the Zone event taking place at the Calgary Zoo.

**Kim Erickson** |Polio Plus| There has been a dramatic increase in polio cases in past 3 months - here is an <u>article describing Rotary's response</u>. Bad News - explosion of cases

Good News- Rotary's surveillance is tracking and detecting more effectively we have been a major player in infrastructure which will support health after polio is eradicated. Fundraising is critical - RI goal is \$50 million
