

I'm sure most of you have heard the news from Gaza. The good news is that we have an aggressive surveillance system as a result of our Polio plus initiatives. We have also had an aggressive response from the WHO, UNICEF and other partners which has resulted in a declaration of peace for three days in the north central and south of Gaza. Well over 600,000 children under the age of 10 will be immunized.

Together, we are making strides toward a polio-free world.

Bad News - Good News

We are still fighting polio in Afghanistan and Pakistan. To date there are 34 cases. The surveillance teams are equipped and able to track and find cases much more readily than in the past. As a result, more cases have been discovered. The good news is that once cases are discovered, precautions can be made effectively.

World Health Organization. Numbers now at 34. Wild Polio Virus Summary:

The number of wild polio cases for **2024** as of Sept 1, 2024 is **34**.

There were 17 in Pakistan and 17 in Afghanistan.

PolioPlus Society


Remembering the child in each polio case

The PolioPlus Society is a program currently being used by the Districts throughout the Rotary World

What is the PolioPlus Society? In an effort to increase sustainable giving, the PolioPlus Society (PPS) was formed to encourage Rotarians to commit to a minimum of \$100 per year to the PolioPlus Fund until polio is eradicated from the face of the earth. Society members receive a special PPS pin, an End Polio Now bracelet, and a certificate.

How to donate to PolioPlus thru the PPS:

- 1. Go to <u>my.rotary.org/donate</u> and click on "Polio Fund".
- 2. We encourage Rotarians to join *PolioPlus Direct* (the recurring option). Signing up for automatic giving with a credit card. \$10 (or more) per month will qualify them for the society.
- 3. Of course, they can also donate through their club.
