Local Funded Projects	To provide local financial assistance for needs relating to health, hunger, water and literacy and other needs that are deemed appropriate to receive funding from the Club	Responsible for announcing grant opportunity, review applications, and recommend funding to the Board.	Grants up to approximately 5,000
Local Major Projects	To partner with community entities in providing a product or service that aligns with a Rotary cause and meets that entity's prioritized need.	The Committee is responsible for soliciting and evaluating ideas from community partners as well as our membership for projects with a larger commitment by the Club than Funded or Hands On Local projects.	May include financial contribution of \$5,000 or more, volunteer labor, and other resources provided by the Club membership. A major project may last for multiple years from planning through full implementation
