Leavenworth Rotary is proud to offer scholarship opportunities to students who have completed graduation requirements. We welcome applications from students within the Cascade School District. These include Cascade High School, Upper Valley Christian High School, Home School students, and those who have completed their GED in the 2022-23 school year. Students whose parent(s) are Rotarians are not eligible to apply. It is our hope that as you pursue higher education through Vocational/Technical Schools, Colleges, and Universities, that you will embrace the spirit of Rotary which can be summarized as "Service Above Self".

Our three scholarships are valued at \$1,200, \$1,500 and \$1,800. A committee of Rotarians will read your application and invite you for a personal interview. Although academic achievement is important, our scholarships will not be awarded on academics alone. How well you answer your questions, express yourself during the interview, and your involvement in school and extra-curricular activities will carry as much weight in our decision-making process as your G.P.A. We are very interested in how you have demonstrated "Service Above Self". Especially service projects independent of school organizations or requirements.
