Leavenworth YE Committee Member Overview & Specific Responsibilities

Inbound Student Support/Counselor – Mary Kostka Overview:

Responsible for being a source of information before arrival into this country. After arrival the counselor is a support person who guides and assists the student.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Preparing for and attending Youth Exchange Committee meetings.
- 2. Establish contact Student prior to arrival to communicate the supporting role for the student that you have.
- 3. Become familiar with the rules of the program.
- 4. Establish an emergency fund for the student with yourself and the Youth Exchange Officer as cosigners along with the student.
- 5. Check that the Student has return airline tickets. Assist student in rebooking the flight extending their stay until the week of July 15th.
- 6. Develop a close relationship, becoming a go-to confidant, and source of support for the student.
- 7. Receipt from inbound student of the Weekly Club Report and forwarding it to the committee Social & Information Coordinator.
- 8. Contact the host Student once per month, receive Host Family report from HF Coordinator, and enter these contacts into the YEAH Portal.
- 9. Arrange for the method of students allowance with the club Treasurer to be dispersed at Club meetings.
- 10. Inbound Orientation (Penticton): Attend with Student. Make sure the student takes the following to Canada: Passport, 2019 form, Proof of insurance, return ticket home, and Canadian Visa if required.
- 11. Keep the Club YEO assessed of the progress of the student and of any concerns that might arise.
- 12. Establish contact with Student's parents, informing them of the students progress. (Bi-Quarterly)
- 13. Be acquainted with the rules of the program contained in District literature.
- 14. Debrief Inbound student and solicit input student and Counselor for program modification.
- 15. Return the Student's reserve fund, checking with the Host Family Coordinator regarding any outstanding student debts.
- 16. Check airline tickets, and contact parents to verify travel information before the current student departs.
