



Standards of Behaviour

Welcome to Rotary Youth Exchange District 5060. Rotary Districts around the world participate in Youth Exchange and as partners in exchange we try to adhere to similar Standards of Behaviour. Violations of our standards of behaviour can result in any of the following actions by either your Hosting Club or the District Chairperson:

Verbal warning

Yellow Card and Written Contract for Behaviour

Red Card and immediate return home

These steps could occur in sequence or; at the discretion of either your Hosting Club or the District Chairperson and in consultation with the District Chairperson in your Home Country, any step could be skipped depending on the severity of the violation. Your family will always be notified of any violation of the Standards of Behaviour. Your family or Home District may be asked to assist us in helping you to understand and cooperate with the Standards of Behaviour.

Standards of Behaviour:

- Dealing or taking illegal drugs
- Driving any motor vehicle
- Sexual and/or exclusive serious relationships
- Drinking alcohol*/ ingesting/inhaling marijuana without host family
- Obtaining a tattoo or piercing
- Negative attitude towards the Youth Exchange program
- Disregard of host family rules
- Unsatisfactory academic effort or attendance at school
- Disrespectful attitude towards the host family, Rotary members
- Travel not approved by either Rotary or host family
- Visits prior to March 15, 2020 or any visitor from home other than immediate family member without prior approval
- Negative attitude towards host Rotary Club and their activities

*Small amount of alcohol may be consumed if offered by host family or Rotarian at special events or holidays. E.g. a glass of wine or beer for a festive toast.

Rotary District 5060 is proud of their Youth Exchange program and we want you to succeed. A good attitude and understanding of the expectations that are outlined in the Standards of Behaviour will assist you in having a successful exchange.
