

Club Members Encouraged to “Create Hope in the World” by Supporting the Rotary Foundation

By the end of the first half of the 2023-24 Rotary Year the membership of the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise has achieved 42 % of its commitment to the Annual Fund of the Rotary International Foundation. As of December 31, 2023, 36 % of the club’s members had contributed US \$7,310 to the Foundation, a club per capita level of US \$122. Considering that the goal of the club is to have its members donate at least US \$17,500 to the Annual Fund by June 30, 2024, the club now has a major challenge before it.



All Rotarians are reminded that through the humanitarian service provided by the Rotary Foundation, Rotary International and its 1.4 million Rotarians worldwide serving in over 46,000 worldwide member clubs, we are able to make a difference in helping those in need throughout the world.
