

District 5060 Matches Club Funds for Second Project with Padrino Children's Foundation in Mexico

The Mexican project, approved by The Rotary Foundation in May of 2021, supplements an earlier approved project supporting the Padrino Children's Foundation in Todos Santos. This second grant will provide funding for Technology requirements for patient data (diagnosis, medical history and quality measurement tools) and family information at a project cost of \$US6,200, involving \$US3,100 from funds from the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise and a matching grant of the same value from District Designated Funds.



The first grant, which was approved in 2020, delayed for implementation due to the Covid Pandemic, will proceed at the same time as the second project. It will target "Early Diagnosis and Intervention for Neurodevelopmental Disorders," whereby public healthcare providers will be taught to use the Child Development Evaluation tool and will show parents of pre-school children basic early childhood stimulation techniques. Once the staff is trained, they will be able to use that training with new families.
