This regulation will be applied starting in Spring 2025 and for that cycle we will consider whether the applicant received grants in both 2024 cycles. Kindly take this into account when contemplating grant applications for the current cycle and the Fall 2024 cycle.

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR PRESENTING YOUR REQUEST

We hope the following guidelines will assist you in the development of your application. We do not expect your project to meet all of these. We do retain the right to add or delete criteria as the Club sees fit.

- The project will have a high impact on the people of Sonoma Valley and provide an avenue for recognition of our club's support.
- The project champions language learners.
- The project champions teachers.
- The project is focused on supporting the youth of Sonoma Valley.
- The project has a component in which some of our members will contribute their time to it.
- There are no other funding sources for the project.
- This funding is for a specific project or capital need.
- This funding is for one year, not a commitment to funding over multiple years.
- We can complete the project and turn it over to non-Rotarians to maintain / continue.
- The project description and financial needs are clear and complete.

### **Club Grant Policies**

Please know that we will not approve grant requests for the following needs:

- Administrative or other salaries. Any non-salaried compensation must be specific to the project/initiative and clearly identified in the grant description.
- Projects supported by parents for the benefit of their own children.
- Projects for religious or political purposes.
- · Projects for individuals.
- Projects of a controversial nature.

### Grant Requests vs. Available Resources

Our Community Service grant process seeks to spread available resources across a wide spectrum of need in Sonoma Valley. Recent grant awards have ranged from \$500 to \$5,000. Grant awards are reviewed by a panel of Rotarians who may recommend partial funding of a request based on our available resources.
