Rotary Club of Vacaville supports:


- <u>Play for All Park This local park is an</u> all-inclusive, welcoming, and accessible place for children of all abilities.
- Scholarships: Rotary provides \$30,000 in annual scholarships for graduating seniors from all of the high schools in Vacaville.
- High School Involvement: We send local high school students to overnight leadership and entrepreneurial camps – Camp Royal and Camp Venture – every year. We also sponsor and mentor Vaca High's Interact Club.
- Spelling Bee: Our club organizes the annual Grace B. Powell citywide spelling bee targeting elementary and middle school students.
- Opportunity House/Festival of Trees:
 Our club supports our local homeless shelter with funds and hands-on projects.



We have partnered with Rotary clubs locally and internationally to:

- Improve educational opportunities for children in Guatemala.
- Construct a maternity clinic in rural Kenya to improve mother and infant survival rates.
- Help in the fight to eradicate polio world-wide.
