



GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP

Global Grant Scholarships are for students that are entering a Master's or Doctorate program at any foreign university of one's choice in a country where there is a qualified Rotary Club.

Two Global Grant Scholarship Awardees received scholarships in June 2024 for Masters' Degree in Legal Studies in Peacebuilding and Conflict Prevention at University of Auckland, New Zealand and at The University of Edinburgh, Scotland.

These scholarships fund **graduate-level coursework or research** for students who have been accepted in graduate programs related to the following areas of focus:

- Peacebuilding and conflict prevention
- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water, sanitation and hygiene
- Maternal and child health
- Basic education and literacy
- Community economic development
- Environment

The annual scholarship is **\$31,000**. It is comprised of contributions from Rotary International, District 5300 and from the sponsoring Rotary Club.

The Committee will consider the following **qualifications** for a candidate's eligibility to receive the Global grant scholarship:

- Proven leadership skills and relevant future application
- A record of success in the academic field or vocation
- Demonstrated commitment to community service
- Well-defined and realistic goals
- Concrete ideas for advocating within their chosen field
- Goals and objectives aligned with those of Rotary International

May	The committee will submit the application to Rotary International for the final
	approval.
June	The Scholarship recipient will be selected and notified of the decision.
