## Dr. Emy Flores, Superintendent of the West Covina Unified School District (WCUSD)



Dr. Flores has served as the West Covina Unified School District (WCUSD) Superintendent since January 2022. A lifelong educator and leader, she has dedicated more than 30 years to transforming schools into places where students discover their voice, passions, and potential.

Born in Guatemala, Dr. Flores immigrated to Los Angeles at the age of nine, where public education became the foundation for her path to independence and success. That personal journey continues to shape her leadership today as she works to ensure every student, regardless of background, has the access, support, and opportunities they need to thrive. Deeply patriotic, she remains grateful for the opportunities this country has provided her and brings that sense of purpose to her work in education.

Before coming to West Covina, Dr. Flores served as Superintendent of Evergreen School District in San Jose, where she guided the district through the pandemic and led critical fiscal recovery efforts. Her career began as a paraprofessional and has since included roles as teacher, principal, executive director, assistant superintendent, and superintendent, reflecting her deep commitment to every level of education.

Since joining WCUSD, Dr. Flores has strengthened the district's financial foundation while expanding academic and enrichment opportunities. She has advanced International Baccalaureate and Dual Immersion programs and significantly grown Career Technical Education pathways in business, culinary arts, nursing, aviation, and cosmetology - preparing students for both college and high-demand careers. She launched a comprehensive Theater and Performing Arts program, broadened music education to include mariachi, drumline, folklórico, and ballroom dance, and expanded state and nationally recognized programs in Speech
