

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL TWIN/SISTER CLUB AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this 15 day of February 2022, by and between The Rotary Club of Oro Valley, Arizona, USA, District 5500 and The Rotary Club of Gualán, Zacapa, Guatemala, District 4250, mutually agreeing to work together on common projects, agreeing to have great fellowship together in the years to come and agreeing to share benefits and benevolence with each other.

ARTICLE I – PURPOSE

It is the aim of both parties to carry out various activities in order to contribute to the peace of the world by intensifying international understanding through mutual exchanges between both Rotary Clubs and their members.

ARTICLE II - ACTIVITIES

The content of the activities shall be as follows:

- 1. Exchange of publications (bulletins, announcements and membership lists), including electronic media such as club presentations and DVD's;
- 2. Encourage Student Exchange and Friendship Exchange Programs; and,
- 3. Other subjects, projects and programs of common interest after mutual evaluation, consultation and agreement.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

This agreement shall come into effect on the date first stated above and last for twenty (20) years. The agreement shall be extended for a further twenty (20) years under mutual consent.

ARTICLE IV - ANNIVERSARY OF SIGNING OF THIS AGREEMENT

Each representative of both clubs concerned hereby has signed this agreement on the dates below and this agreement is effective from February 15, 2022, which shall be fixed and celebrated every year as the anniversary of the signing of this Rotary Sister Club Agreement.

ARTICLE V – REPORT TO ROTARY INTERNATIONAL

Both clubs shall immediately report the signing and execution of this agreement to ROTARY INTERNATIONAL through the Governor of its respective Rotary District.
