# DROP OUT RATE DATA

'Arizona's High School Drop Out Rate is 23%!

Pima County's Drop Out Rate is 29%!

Over 22,000 Pima County High School aged youth have dropped out of school since 2020.

# EDGE'S ROLE IN THE COMMUNITY?

Reduce the local drop-out rate by re-engaging youth who have disengaged from schools by providing individualized instruction, support, and wrap around services.



The COVID-19 pandemic, forced schools across the globe to address learning loss, credit recovery, and mental health.

EDGE has been doing so since 1985!

## OUR WHY

- Educational system is flawed and doesn't meet the needs of all students
- Too many students go unseen, unheard, unvalued, sometimes ignored, and at worst shamed or judged
- Systemic barriers exists that many students from thriving
- Metrics used to evaluate schools too often result in schools treating students
  as data points rather than human beings which results in students being
  "coached out."



## WHO EDGE SERVES

- Students between the ages of 14–22.
- Students from all over Pima County including; Tucson, Oro Valley, Catalina, Oracle, Marana, Red Rocks, Vail, South Tucson, & Sahuarita
- 71% of student body lives in poverty
- 8% homeless youth
- 18% students with disabilities



#### Arizona's Public Charter Schools Just the Facts

- Charter schools are public schools serving public students.
- Every public charter school enters a contract with the state to improve student achievement and is held accountable for results.
- As public schools, charters are open to all children, do not require entrance exams, cannot charge tuition, and must participate in state testing and federal accountability programs.
- Public charter schools must accept all students including those with disabilities and English learners.
- Public charters receive less funding than district schools.
- Arizona's public charters reflect the state's diversity with a majority-minority enrollment.
- Charters excel academically: in 2019, the last year of available achievement data before the pandemic, 73% of Arizona's charter schools received either an "A" or "B" letter grade.
- Public charter schools must follow all applicable federal and state laws.

#### FUN FACTS

- Edge is the oldest charter school in Pima County, and one of the ten oldest in the state, operating as a charter school since 1995.
- EDGE is an acronym that stands for <u>ED</u>ucational <u>Group Effort High School which</u> represents our vision for education in which an entire community are partners in educating youth.
- Prior to the charter school legislation that passed in 1995, EDGE operated as early as 1985 as grant funded credit recovery program run by Pima County.
- EDGE operated TUSD and Sunnyside Unified School District's first credit recovery programs prior to receiving charter school status.


