- Federally designated, not-for-profit Organ Procurement Organization (OPO)
- Cover the entire state of Arizona
- Main office in Tempe and satellite office in Tucson
- Support donor families during the donation process
- Collaborate to preserve the option for donation
- Determine medical suitability for organ, eye and tissue donation

The life saving and healing gifts of organ and tissue donation begin with a routine referral call.



HOW ARE WE MEED?



Donation Authorization

First Person Authorization

- Uniform Anatomical Gift Act (UAGA) will go into effect <u>after</u> death
- If the donor is registered and under the age of 18, then both parents must consent to donation.

Legal Next-of-Kin/Authorized Decision Maker

• If an individual is <u>not</u> registered, <u>and</u> there is potential for donation, the family will be given information to make an informed decision based on *their values and beliefs*.

Family Care During Donation

Donation & Family Advocates (DFA) work with hospital staff to continue to support families during the donation process.

- Determine the best timing for meaningful conversation
- Bereavement support & materials
- Heartbeat strips, handprints, Moment of Silence, etc.
- Funeral home arrangements
- Organ donation outcome & number of lives saved after recovery
- Location of loved one after recovery
- Continue to support the donor family after donation for two years
