



The Terrence Pickrel Heart Fund seeks to help these patients lessen their financial burden by providing modest financial assistance.

Requests are vetted by hospital social workers and are needs-based. Awards of up to \$500 per year to patients receiving care in Arizona are available, funds permitting.






Don't let the government decide where your hard-earned money goes. The Arizona Charitable Tax Credit allows taxpayers to make charitable contributions and receive dollar-for-dollar reductions in their Arizona state tax liabilities.

#### What Does This Mean For You?

If you donate to an approved Arizona Charity you will receive a credit on your AZ state taxes. The maximum Qualifying Charitable Organization (QCO) credit donation amount for 2023 is \$421 for single people, married couples filing separate or head of household and \$841 for married people filing jointly.
