- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR TO ALL CONCERNED?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Howard and Mary Ann Tatum were charter members of The Rotary Club of Dove Mountain and both served as presidents of the club. They were drawn to Rotary because of their belief in its guiding principles and their commitment to service. They lived Rotary's motto: Service Above Self.

It was their devotion to lifting up youth and their belief in lifelong learning that inspired this scholarship.

Application Contents

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Two letters of reference from adults in your life other than relatives (teacher, scout leader, minister, etc.) attesting to your adherence to ethical principles in your daily life and your commitment to service. These should include that person's relationship to you and how long they have known you. Specific examples are helpful.
- 3. A brief biographical sketch including your school activities, hobbies and interests, employment history.
- 4. A description of the ways in which you demonstrate Service Above Self.
- 5. Transcript of courses and grades.
- 6. Description of an ethical dilemma you have faced and an explanation of how you resolved the dilemma.
- 7. A 750- to 1000-word essay describing how The Four-Way Test applies to your life and how you provide service to others.

Personal History 15%

- 1. Letters of recommendation (3 points)
- 2. School activities or employment (3 points)
- 3. Hobbies and interests (3 points)
- 4. Ethical dilemma (3 points)
- 5. Transcript (3 points)

Service to Others 10%

- 1. Letters of recommendation (2 points)
- 2. Service activities (8 points)

Original Essay 75%

- 1. Content 50%
 - Application of the Four-Way Test in your life (20 points)
 - Application of Service Above Self in your life (15 points)
 - Use of examples from your life experiences (15 points))

2. Language 15%

- Spelling (4 points)
- Grammar (4 points)
- Punctuation (3 points)
- Word choice, effectiveness (4 points)

3. Organization 10%

- Introduction that establishes major themes (3 points)
- Development of ideas in clear, logical order with examples (4 points)
- Conclusion that summarizes major themes (3 points)
