## **GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP**

## Offered Through ROTARY CLUB OF AUSTIN

**PURPOSE:** Provide a grant for post-baccalaureate study in one of seven Areas of Focus at an accredited university located in a country outside the United States.

AREAS OF FOCUS: Peacebuilding and Conflict Prevention; Disease Prevention and Treatment; Water, Sanitation and Hygiene; Maternal and Child Health; Basic Education and Literacy; Community Economic Development; and Supporting the Environment.

**AMOUNT:** \$30,000.

**GRANT TERM:** One to four years. The grant must start with the applicant's first year of study.

**INSTITUTIONAL ADMISSION:** The applicant must be admitted, on his or her own initiative, to the university program before Rotary International will approve the Scholarship.

**ROTARY PRESENCE:** The university must be in a location where Rotary has a presence in order for a club to serve as a host.

**APPLICATION:** An application form, provided by Rotary, must submitted to the Club no later than November 7, 2022.

**INTERVIEWS:** The Rotary Club of Austin will conduct initial interviews. The person, recommended by the Club, will then interview with the District 5870 committee that will make the final selection.

**TIME SCHEDULE:** The initial Club interview will be scheduled on a date prior to November 19, 2022. The District interview is scheduled for December 10, 2022. The grantee will begin their program at the selected university in the Fall Semester, 2023.
