

# District Grant Policies 2024-2025

The District Grants Committee has met and established policies for District Grants for the 2021 -2021 Rotary year.

The amount of available funds will be \$101,183.00. Once this total is reached no further grants will be approved.

The maximum District Grant amount available for each club will be \$3,000. A District Grant will match \$2 for \$1 the amount contributed by the club for a project, up to \$3,000. As an example, a project costing \$3,000 would be funded \$2,000 by a District Grant and \$1,000 by the club. Grant Applications will be accepted between July 1 and November 30, 2024.

Rotary Clubs are required to have at least one representative attend the annual Grant Management Seminar and turn in to the District 6110 office a signed Memorandum of Understanding to participate in foundation grants. A refresher training will be held on September 14, 2024.

District Grant applications will be made online, using the application process accessible through DaCdb via the Rotary District 6110 website ([RotaryDistrict6110.org](https://RotaryDistrict6110.org)). To begin the application process, go to the DaCdb home page and click on "Grants," then "Club Grants" and then follow directions.

We encourage variety and anticipate that these grants will be used for one-time projects and not to finance normal club budgetary items. It is highly recommended that you contact your Assistant Governor if you need help with the mechanics of applying for grants electronically.

All projects must be completed and a Final Report submitted online to the District Grant Committee before reimbursement can be made. It is important that Final Report include copies of all receipts, cancelled check and publicity resulting from the project. The deadline for submitting 2024-2025 final reports is November 30, 2025.

The per-capita amount that a club's members contribute to the Annual Fund (AF) of the Rotary Foundation will be considered by the District Grants Committee. For the Rotary year 2024 - 2025, a minimum club contribution for the preceding year is expected to average at least \$100 per member. Applications from clubs with AF contributions averaging less than \$100 per member will be tabled until it is determined that all clubs who meet the minimum requirements have applied for District Grants.
