Who is the student?

We receive applications from overseas in February/March. So, at the time you are looking for host families, we do not yet have specific information on the student that your club will be hosting.

But, we do know some information.

- Age: between 15 and 18.5 upon arrival in the USA
- School: a student in the top 1/3 of his or her grade/year at school
- English: Student submits a proof of English proficiency to handle day-to-day life in English

What is expected of a host family?

Before the student arrives,

- participate in training/orientation sessions.
- Understand the program rules
- Know how to contact Youth Exchange Rotarians in case of emergency
- Communicate with the student

During the exchange

- Provide a safe and welcoming environment
- Make the student feel like part of the family
- Provide room and board for the student. All students must have their own bed.
- Provide a place where the student can study
- Recognize the student's birthday and special occasions
- Know how to access & use the student's medical insurance policy
- Discuss any concerns with the host Rotary counselor (including homesickness, difficulty at school, illness, etc.)
- Supervise the student, exercising parental responsibility
- Encourage involvement in community life
- Teach the student about local culture and learn about the student's culture

How long is the student with a host family?

Most long-term exchange students live with three families. So, your student may live with you about 3 to 4 months. Typically, students arrive in mid-August, and they change families after Thanksgiving (late November) and around Spring break (mid-March).
