STRUCTURE

Term

The Red Badge term is for about 6 months, the January through June Block and July through December Block. Members who join in the last 2 months of a 6-month Block will join the following block. This ensures plenty of time in the committee to fully learn about Rotary and our club.

Seating

If desired, Red Badge members can have a designated Red Badge table to provide a comfortable place to sit, visit with other new members, and plan their activities.

CHALLENGES

Plan an Event

The committee will plan and execute a social gathering, inviting the entire membership and potential members. OR The committee will plan and execute a small fundraiser or community service event.

Greet Members

Committee members will greet members and scan badges for attendance recording. They will also recite the 4-way test at the meeting. This helps new members get to know existing members.

Engage Rotaract Members

Communicate and interact with the Rotaract Club members and be sure that our two clubs mutually benefit each other and are included in joint activities.

Make a Presentation

The Red Badge Committee will present a program in the last month of their Block (June or December), in coordination with the program committee. This program will be an educational presentation about some aspect of Rotary and what it does for our world. At the end of the program, there will be a ceremonial presentation of their Blue Badges and acknowledgement of their individual contributions.

Committee Chair

The graduating committee chooses one from among their members to Chair the committee for the next block.
