



# Honor a Veteran

You and your family, friends or organization may honor a Veteran with their name, rank, service, or preferred wording on an engraved brick to be part of the walkways at the Robert L. Cook Veterans Memorial Plaza at Rose Park.

*For each brick, there is a maximum of 3 lines with 21 characters per line (including spaces).*

Bricks are placed twice a year. Bricks ordered no later than **March 15th** will be placed for Memorial Day and bricks ordered no later than **August 31st** will be placed for Veterans Day.

The memorial would provide a tribute to the many Veterans who served our country.

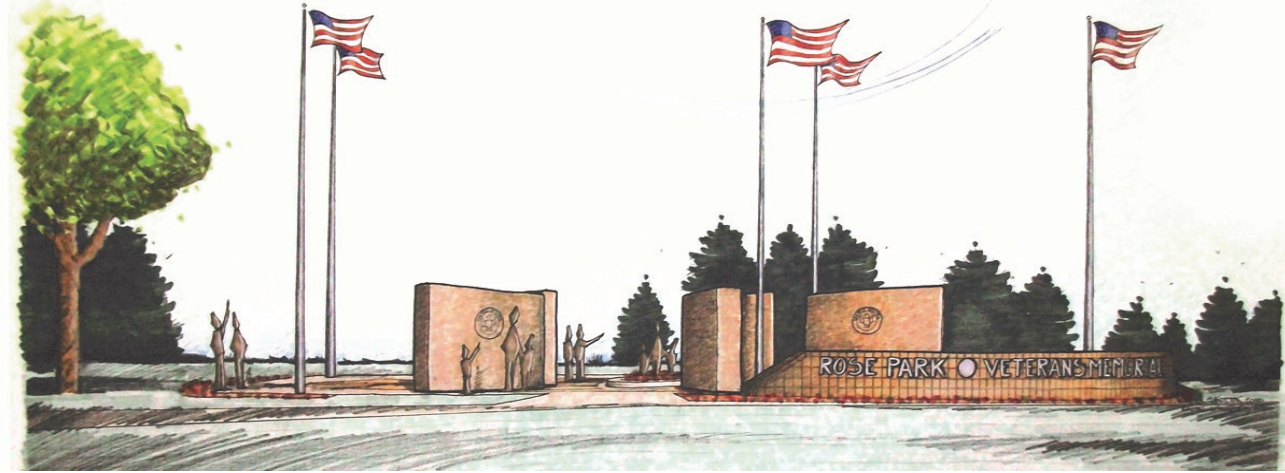
