



Policy on the D6400 Water and Sanitation Fund

The Rotary Foundation title for this fund is the “Jennifer Jones and Nicholas Krayacich Pooled Funds for Water and Sanitation” which is “Endowed / Directed Gift E10953”.

In any Rotary Year, the maximum amount to be allocated to a single Global Grant is one-quarter of the total balance available in that Rotary Year, allocated on a first come first serve basis with ties broken with an allocation to the club with the earliest project implementation dates. The amount allocated to the Global Grant must not exceed the budgeted cost of the portion of the Global Grant specifically related to “Water and Sanitation” under either the “Water, Sanitation and Hygiene” or the “Environment” area of focus.

Date of Initial Approval: 2018-2019 Rotary year.

Dates of Amendments: October 22, 2020, November 27, 2023

History:

1. The original policy had a maximum allocation to clubs of \$2,000, with special allocations to LaSalle Centennial and Windsor-Roseland of \$7,500, to be used prior to June 30, 2022, in recognition of significant contributions to the endowment fund.
2. The October 22, 2020, amendment was to include special allocations to the Rotary Clubs of Essex and Trenton of \$6,000, to be used prior to June 30, 2023, in recognition of significant contributions to the endowment.
3. The November 27, 2023, amendment was to change the amount available to clubs and to sunset the special allocations to LaSalle Centennial, Windsor-Roseland, Essex, and Trenton.
