#### Friday, October 21, from 7 am-3 pm – ROTARY - COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITY

By now, all of you have received my email requesting volunteers for the October 21 community engagement event. As you may or may not know, our District (in partnership with two other Rotary Districts from Northern Illinois) is bidding on the Rotary International Convention in 2030.

We have an extraordinary opportunity to support a Community Engagement effort. Community Engagement is now a part of the evaluation criterion, and our local districts (6450, 6440, and 6420) are making the most of it.

On Friday, October 21, from 7 am-3 pm, Rotary is renting out Pioneer Court, just north of the Apple Store on Michigan Avenue, right alongside the river, to engage the community. We will set up ShelterBox tents, RILEE - the iron lung, a table to talk about Rotary, and other Rotary materials to engage passersby. We will answer their questions and get information from them to follow up with them as new prospective members.

The RI Convention 2030 committee members will "randomly" stop by that morning to see us in action and visualize what it could look like in 2030. We are looking to spread the word and secure volunteers to help with set-up and breakdown, as well as to engage the community by talking about all the great things Rotary does in the world.
