Springfield Sunrise Rotary Club Community Grant Program

GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS

Eligible Applicants

Applicants must be 501(c)(3) organizations or educational institutions located in Springfield, IL and the surrounding area. Educational institutions include public and private pre-K – grade 12 schools, community colleges, and universities.

Eligible Projects

Projects that serve youth in the Springfield area. Special consideration will be given to programs that serve disadvantaged youth & where a Springfield Sunrise Rotary Club Community Grant will be significant.

Grant Award Amount and Evaluation

Typical grant awards range from \$500 - \$1,000. Approximately \$15,000 will be awarded in total. Grants will initially be evaluated based on a scoring matrix. Points available are listed by each entry. Entries for which no points are given, but which are required are marked (M) for Mandatory. Sunrise Rotary reserves the right to award grants to the programs/entities they feel will benefit most and are most closely aligned with Sunrise Rotary's programs.

Requirements

- Meet eligibility criteria
- Mail completed application, postmarked by Monday, February 16, 2018, to Sunrise Rotary, P.O. Box 5300, Springfield, IL 62705-5300
- Submit the following:
 - o Six copies of the application form and one copy of each of the following:
 - IRS letter documenting 501(c)(3) charitable status or evidence of being an educational institution.
 - Annual Budget
 - List of board of directors of the non-profit organization
 - One publication (brochure or annual report) with information on the organization
- Successful applicants must submit a report upon completion of the project, documenting results of the grant award. Submission of this report is a requirement in order to be eligible for future grant awards from the Springfield Sunrise Rotary Club.

Grant Award Schedule

Applications must be postmarked by Monday, February 16,2018, and notification of grant awards will be made by March 31, 2018.
