



## Rotary International District 6510 Foundation 2024 Scholarship Application

The Rotary International District 6510 Scholarship will fund **two scholarships** to an accredited College or Trade School **to two high school seniors residing in Rotary District 6510**. Awards will be **\$2,500.00** each. Winners will be presented at the High School Senior event where Scholarships are awarded (if possible). Recipients will agree to have their awards publicized throughout Rotary International District 6510.

### Selection Criteria

- Academics at B average or better (Maximum of 5 points)
- School Involvement – Service, Clubs, Athletics, etc.; **cite/explain leadership roles** (officer, chair, section leader, awards, etc.) (Maximum of 10 points)
- Community Involvement and Volunteerism; **cite/explain leadership roles** as above. Include **full/part-time jobs** you have had to support your own ambitions. (Maximum of 10 points)
- Educational and Career Plan (Maximum of 5 points)
- **Essay (max 400 words) describing** how the **Rotary Motto “Service Above Self”** affects, **has affected, or will affect your life in the future** (400-word limit). (Maximum of 10 points)

### Conditions for Receiving Funds

- Student must provide **proof of full-time enrollment** (Tuition bill, Registration form, with official logos)
- Upon proof of enrollment, money will be **paid to the college or university; students must submit tuition bill for fall to receive the \$2500 award.**
- **Withdrawal** from college or university shall result in the **return** of unused portion of funds.

### Application: Fill out Page 3

Completed applications should be **received by March 1st**. Decisions will be made in April.

***Late applications will not be accepted. Do not send photographs with your application.***

# Scholarship Application Guidelines

All documents **single-sided**; no duplex

Because our Scholarship Committee cannot meet together to review applications and select finalists, we must distribute these applications to our Committee via Email. For that reason, **we require that you scan all your application/documents as a single PDF and email it to us.**

Someone you know must have a multi-function printer/scanner/fax/copier. Ask around.

Ask your school for a copy of your **transcript**, including the **fall** grades. It doesn't have to be official; it doesn't have to be in a sealed envelope. Ask them to print it out **single-sided, flat, unfolded.**

The Application page (page 3 in this packet) must be completed. If you use **Adobe Reader**, you may be able to click the 'Fill & Sign' button (in the side panel) to click in each cell and actually type your responses.

## To Scan and Email: **No GoogleDocs or Google Share**

The scanning order **of the Application Packet** is important. Scan all pages into a **single PDF document.**

The correct **scanning order** is:

1. Application page
2. Transcript, all pages
3. Résumé of School Activities and Awards, **including leadership**, projects, etc.
4. Résumé of Community Involvement/Volunteerism, **including leadership**, projects, employment
5. Summary of Educational and Career Goals
6. Essay on the Rotary Motto "Service Above Self" in your life

Remember: scan all pages into a single PDF **What should you name the document???**

Use **LastFirst** (with no spaces). Examples: SmithMary or JonesRobert

As we evaluate your Application, Committee members will be paying close attention to your **service** to others (that's what Rotarians are known for) and your **leadership** in school and all other areas of your life.

### IMPORTANT APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- I have completed **all** parts of the application including **signature** and **date**.
- I have included all required **transcripts**. (Note: Send the most recent transcript.)
- I am planning to email my application so that it will be received by March 1, 2024.
