 - Another idea is the Sleep in Heavenly Peace bed building project
 - In either case the grant needs to be written soon
- Mike will get with Pat on this year's check for Belize
- District Assembly Apr 22nd
- Our club had 3 District Grants this year (normal is 1)
 - Proves that if we keep submitting grants, and there is money available, projects can be funded
